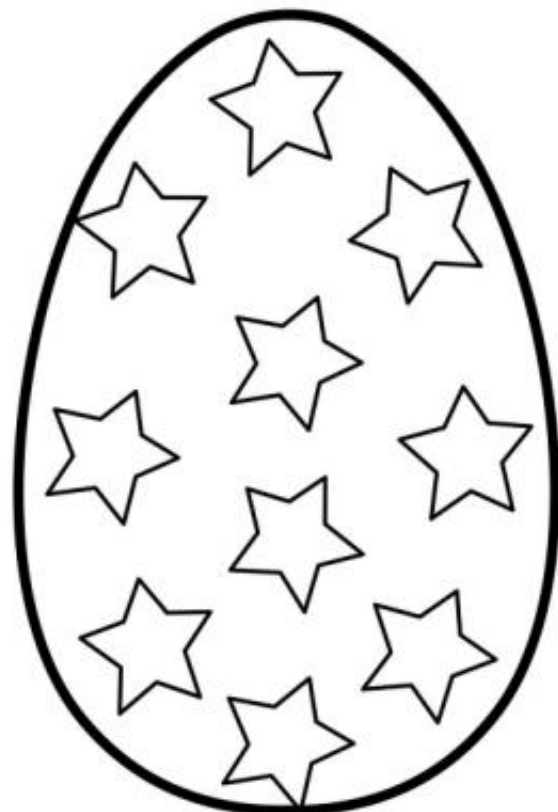
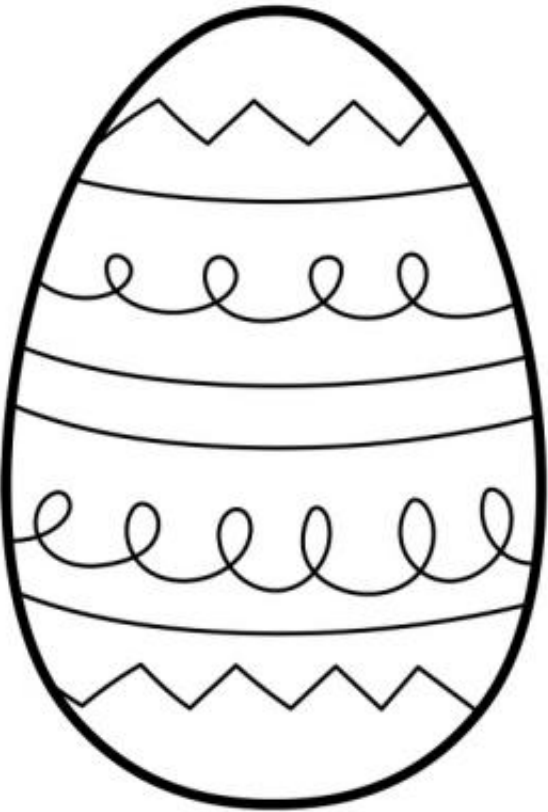
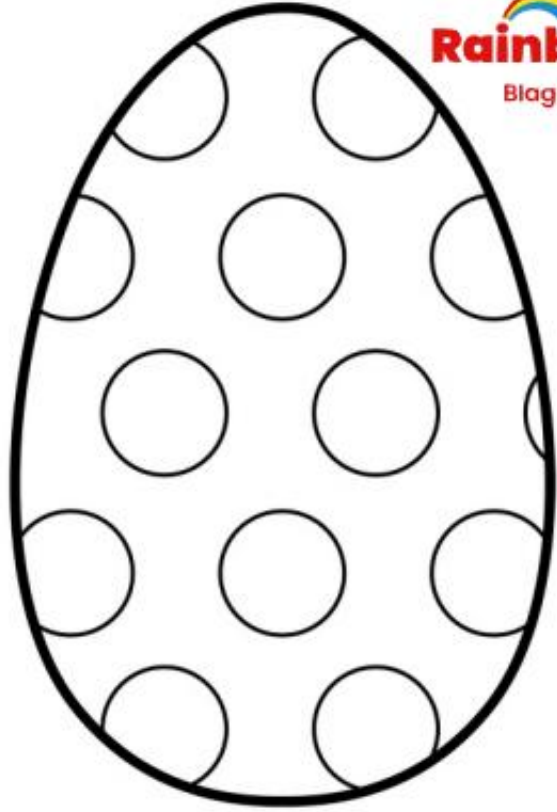
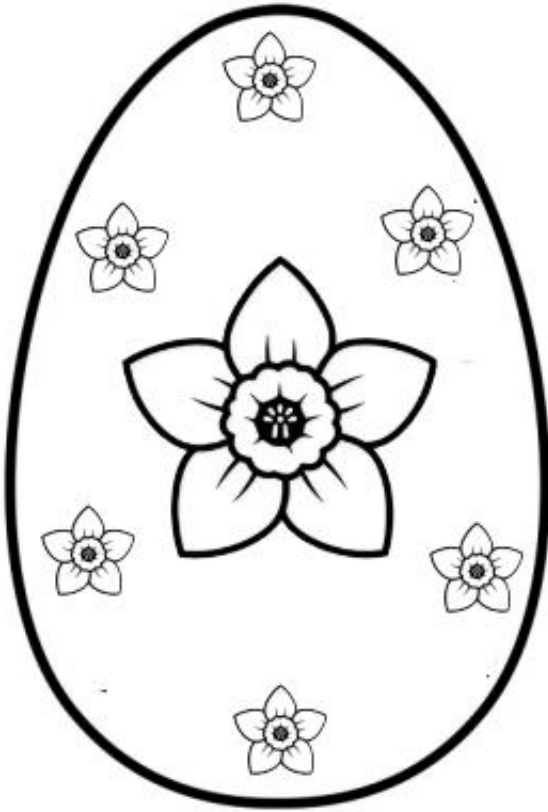


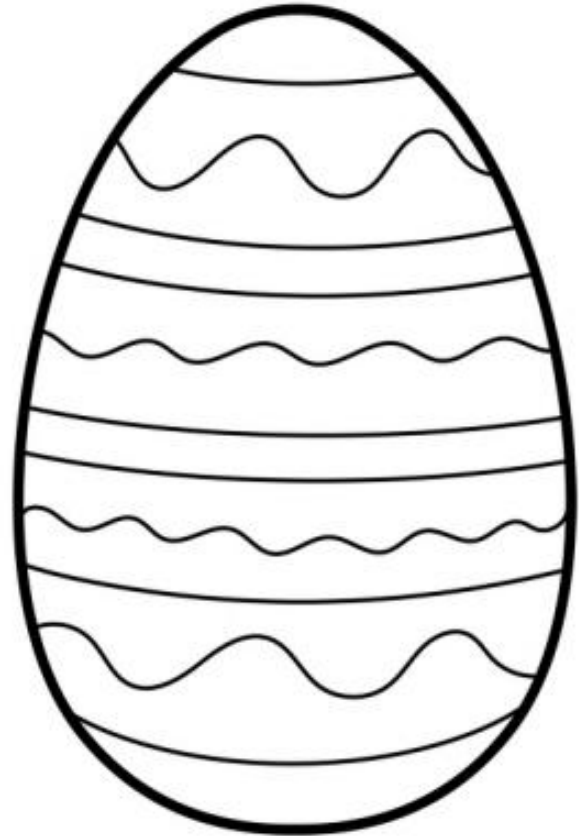
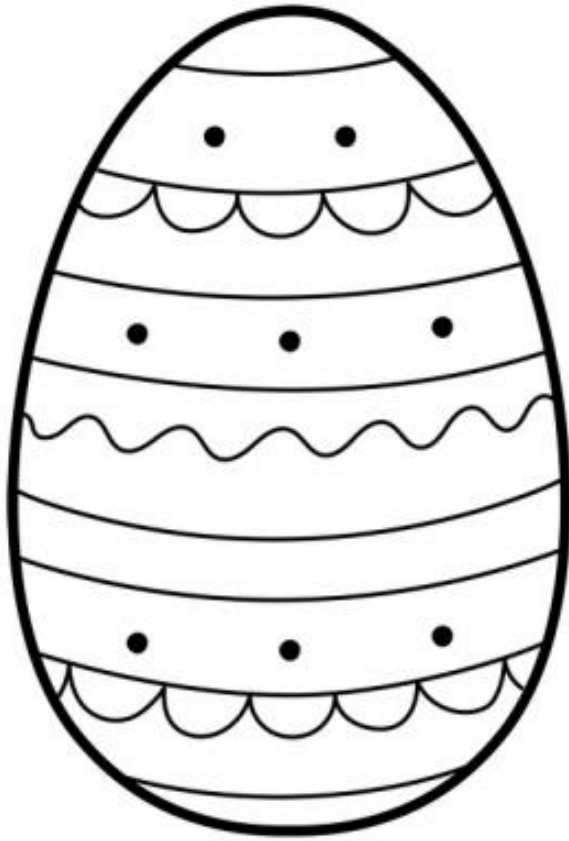
Easter Wreath

Mini Egg Cookies

Ingredients

100g (1/4 cup) butter (softened)

150g (3/4 cup) soft brown sugar

1 egg

½ tsp vanilla extract

200g (1 1/4 cup) self raising flour*

50g (1/4 cup) chocolate chips

2 x 90g packets mini eggs



Preheat the oven to 180C / 170C Fan / 325F and grease or line three baking trays with baking or parchment paper. Miz the butter and sugar and vanilla extract. Combine the egg & flour. Keep the mini eggs in their packet and bash with a rolling pin. Add them and the chocolate chips to your mixture. Place dollops of the cookie dough on to the baking trays and add s few unbroken eggs to the top. Chill in the fridge for 30 minutes before baking for approx 10 minutes. Leave your cookies on the trays for 10 minutes and then cool on a wire rack to cool completely.

Hanging 3D Bunny Craft



Print out each bunny shape on white paper and cut out carefully. Fold each bunny in half lengthways. Glue half wrong side to another bunny's half side, repeat for the 3rd bunny. Place a length of ribbon between the two remaining sides of bunny and glue down before gluing the last two sides together.



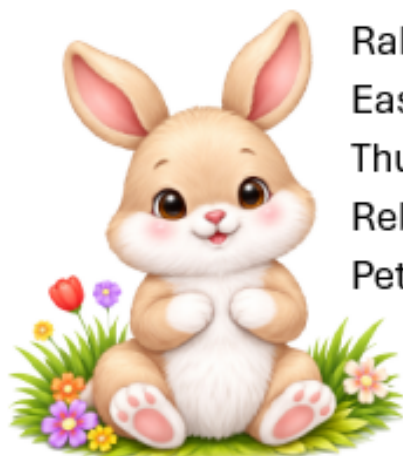

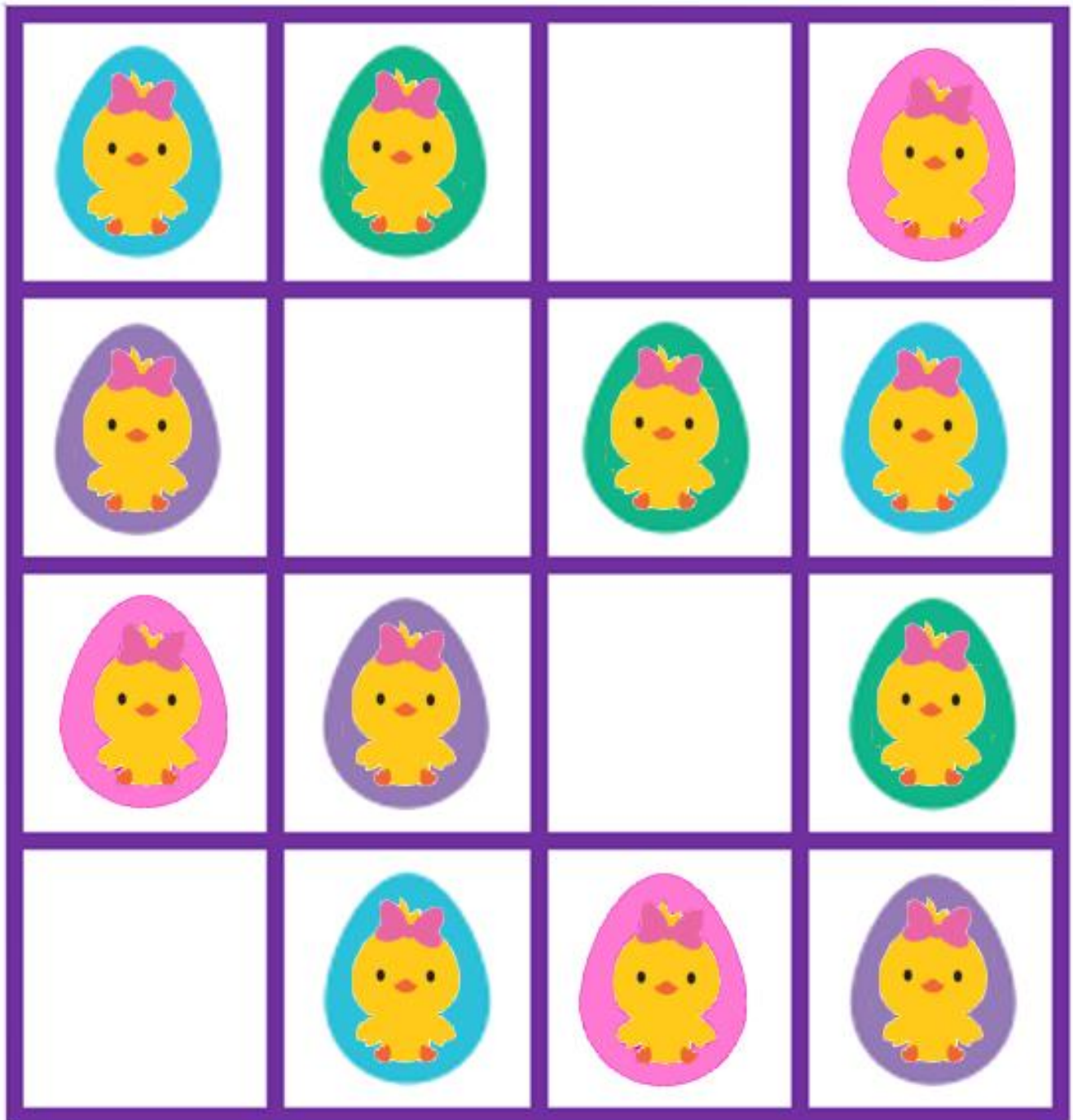

Chocolate Mini Egg Nests

Ingredients

100g shredded wheat crushed

200g of milk chocolate

100g unsalted butter

100g of Golden Syrup

1 pkt of Cadbury Mini Eggs



Melt the chocolate in a double boiler or microwave
Stir in the butter and golden Syrup. Next stir in the
crushed up shredded wheat, mixing really well to
ensure all the shredded wheat gets covered. Spoon
into paper cases in a muffin tray. Next add three
Cadbury mini eggs to top as pictured and leave to
set. You can refridgerate to speed this up.

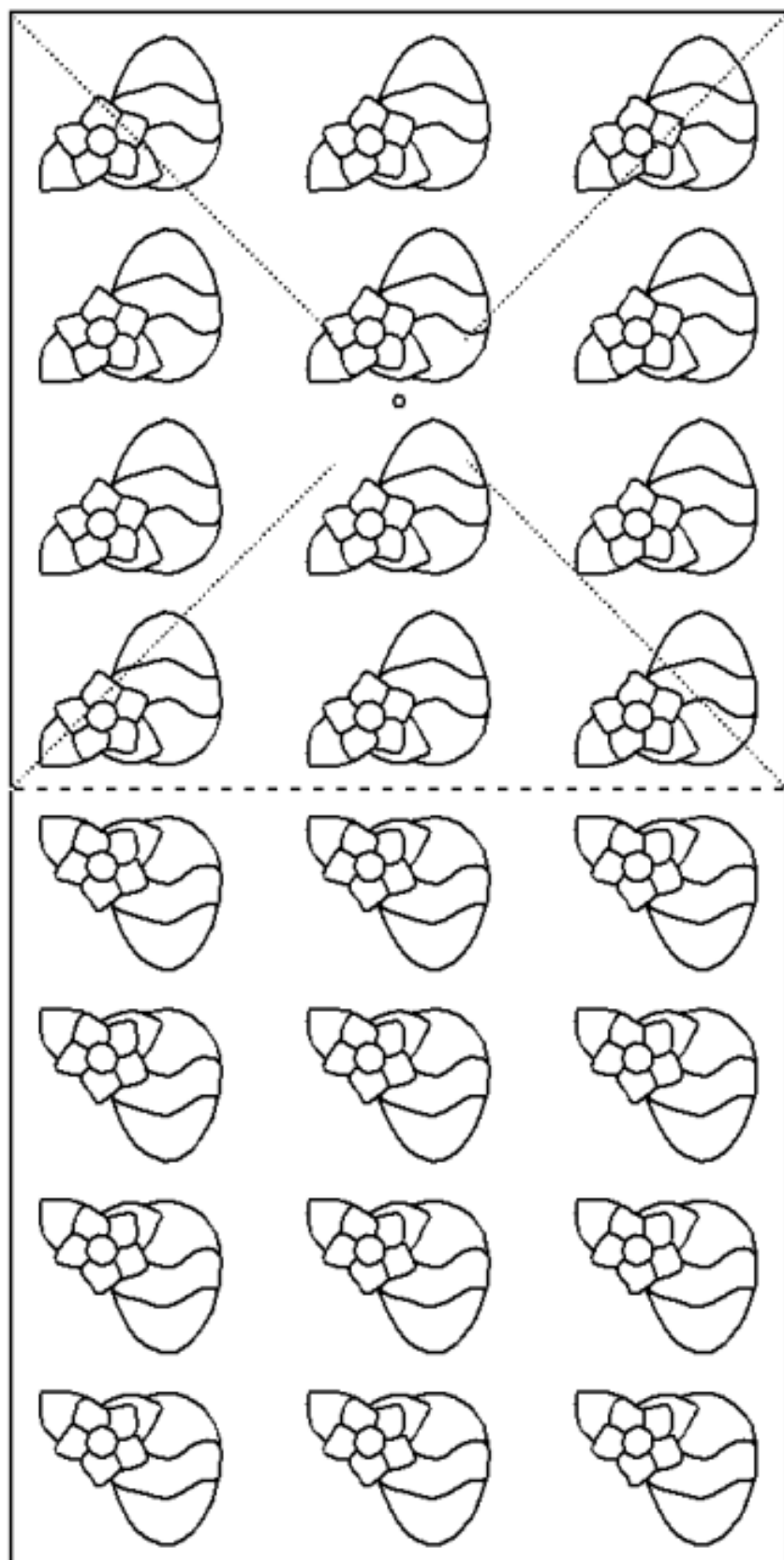
CHOCOLATE BAR WRAPPER

Supplies

Hard Boiled White Eggs
Wax Crayons
Crayon sharpener or fine grater
Several shallow dishes/saucers

Instructions

Hard boil the eggs and keep warm

Choose 2 or 3 crayon colours for each egg. Use a crayon sharpener or grater to make crayon shavings, letting the shavings fall into a shallow dish. While the eggs are still warm gently roll each egg in the crayon shavings.

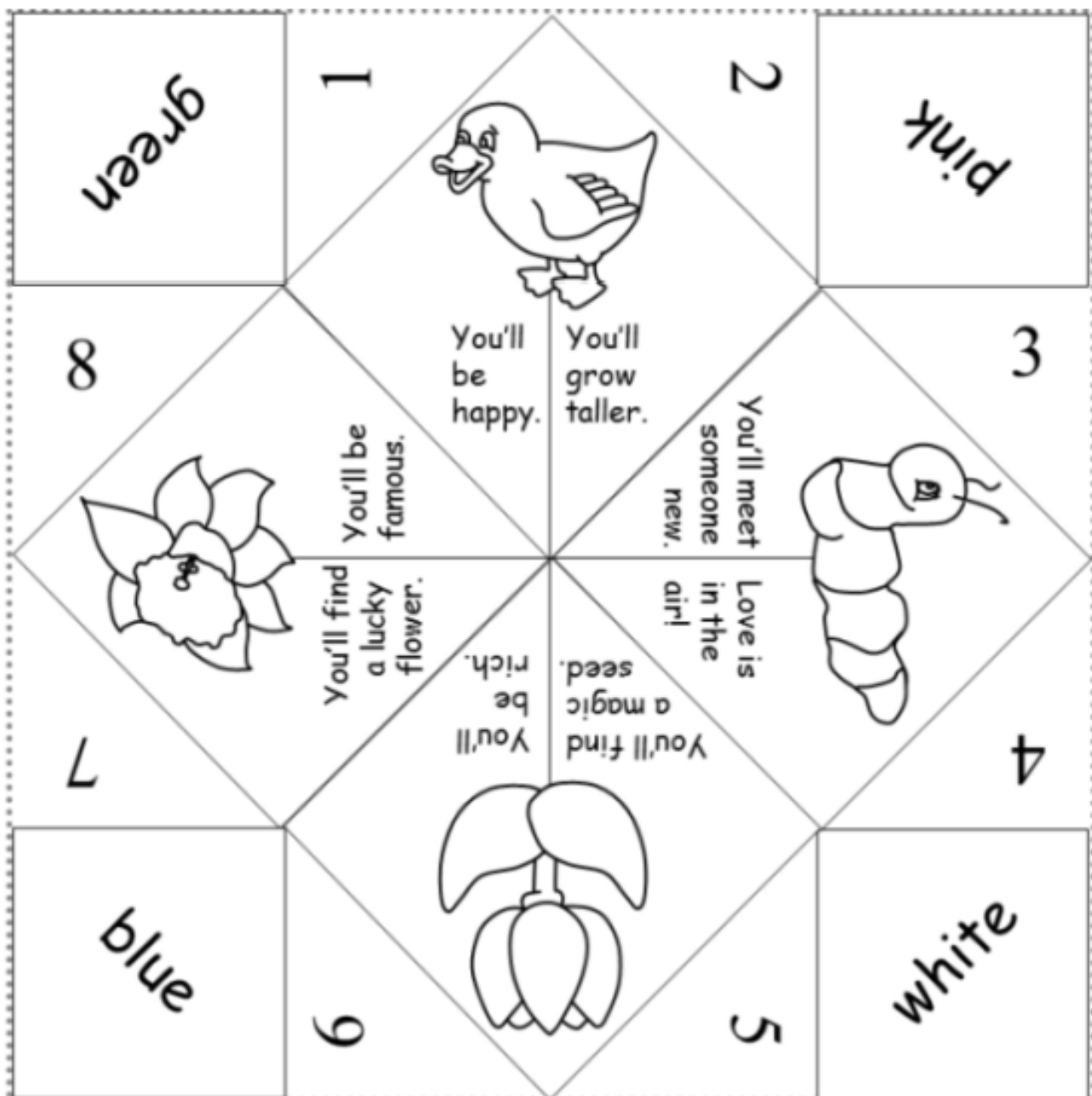
Continue turning the eggs so the melted wax creates a tie dye effect.

Set the eggs aside to cool completely.

Crayola brand crayons work best for melting as they produce vibrant colors and melt easily.

Fortune Teller

1. Colour in and cut around the edge of the square
2. Valley fold paper from corner to opposite corner.
3. Fold corner to corner again making smaller triangle. Unfold.
4. Fold the four corners to the centre of the square
5. Turn over.
6. Fold & unfold the bottom edge of the square to the centre
7. Fold & unfold the left edge of the square over to the right
8. Push the 4 corners of your square to the centre and then slide your fingers under the flaps.





String Egg Ornaments

Supplies

White crochet cotton or cotton yarn
Small water balloons
PVA glue
Pastel coloured acrylic paint
White or clear glitter
Ribbon
Bowl for glue
Wax paper or parchment paper to protect your workspace
Mini foil wrapped eggs

Instructions

Place about 6 foiled mini eggs into the water balloon. Blow up a small balloon so it has an egg shape. Tie it closed. Pour school glue into a bowl. Add some pastel acrylic paint. If needed, thin it slightly with a tiny bit of water so the yarn can move through it easily. Cut about 2 yards of cotton yarn for each ornament. Dip the yarn into the coloured glue and make sure it is fully coated. Wrap the glue-covered yarn around the balloon in different directions to create an open string art look. Leave small spaces between the strands so the ornament looks light and delicate. While the glue is still wet, sprinkle glitter over the yarn. Set the balloon on wax paper or hang it somewhere safe to dry completely. Drying may take about 3 hours, though thicker glue or humid rooms may take longer. Once the yarn is fully dry and stiff, pop the balloon and gently pull the balloon pieces out through one of the gaps. Tie a ribbon at the top for hanging.
